CHERRY HILL ENVIRONMENTAL BOARD MARKS NATIONAL VOLUNTEER WEEK

April 2023

The Cherry Hill Environmental Board (CHEB), an all-volunteer group dedicated to protecting and improving the natural environment for all Cherry Hill residents, celebrated National Volunteer Week by providing multiple groups the opportunity to serve nature.

A group of 20 volunteers from TD Bank removed Garlic Mustard and bamboo, both invasive species, from Bunker Hill Trails. Five Rowan medical students helped to clear and establish a new trail at Evans Pond. Mormon missionaries moved a large pile of compost at Cherry Hill's Lenape Pollinator Garden in preparation for Cherry Hill's Earth Day event: Pollinator Garden Day, when hundreds of pollinator-friendly plants will be planted by over 25 volunteers. Girl Scouts from Cherry Hill also converted vacant garden plots at the GSUSA Cherry Hill office with plants to benefit butterflies and bees.
