Dear Neighbor:

This winter has been unlike any other, and I know we're all looking forward to the first signs of spring—sunshine, warmth, and the return of green spaces. Cherry Hill has so much to offer, and I encourage you to take advantage of our many recreational classes, volunteer opportunities, and community programs and events.

As we move into the next season, we remain focused on public safety. Our Police Department recently welcomed new officers and promoted an additional 11 who exemplify core values of integrity, professionalism, and service. The department continues to be proactive with directed patrols in neighborhoods and school areas, helping to keep our community safe. They are also actively engaged with residents through ongoing school programs and community events, such as the LEAD program in our middle schools, the Citizens Police Academy, and Coffee with a Cop.

CAMDEN COUNTY

HOME IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Income eligible homeowners may be eligible for a 0% interest, deferred payment loan program which provides qualified applicants with funding for needed home repairs. Eligible work items include things such as: exterior, interior, roof, siding, windows, heating systems and electrical systems. The program may not be used for room additions or upgrades.

(Roof, HVAC & Handicap Ramps are forgivable after 10 years)

How does the program work?

If an applicant is deemed eligible, their project is assigned to an approved contractor. Staff monitors all work to ensure it is done correctly and within the guidelines of the program.

What does it cost?

Projects will result in a 0% interest loan in the form of a lien placed on the property. With this lien, no payments are required until the time of sale or a change in ownership.

Who is eligible for the program?

Homeowners must reside within one of the eligible municipalities and the household income must be lower than the income limits below.

Note: Due to program interest, homeowners may be added to a wait list before they can apply to the housing rehabilitation program.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Register online with Visa/Mastercard at <https://register.capturepoint.com/cherryhill>. If a program is full, you may be added to a wait list and contacted if space becomes available. Participants must follow the Township's Code of Conduct, available online. A signed registration waiver is required for all programs, and only registered participants may attend unless noted in the course description.

Cancellations/transfers must be made at least 7 days before class begins. Refunds (minus a \$15 processing fee) will not be given after the first day of class except in case of injury or illness, with a doctor's note. No refunds for classes under \$25 or ticketed events. Classes canceled due to weather or instructor absence will be rescheduled. Courses are subject to minimum enrollment requirements.



SNOW REMOVAL GUIDELINES

Our Public Works Department is working hard to make driving safer and easier in snowy weather. Depending on the duration and amount of snowfall, township trucks may plow your street several times. As snow rolls off our plows, it sometimes accumulates in driveway aprons. Please understand this is unavoidable and is the homeowner's responsibility to clear it. Here are some helpful hints to make snow removal less frustrating:

- Please remove the following items from the street in front of your home:
 1. Trash/recyclable containers. Place on the grassy planter strip between curb and sidewalk.
 2. Portable basketball backboard systems.
- Do not park cars on the street from 1 hour after the snow has stopped. This speeds the removal process and prevents cars from being plowed in.
- If possible, wait until the township trucks have made at least 3 passes on your street before cleaning your driveway.
- Shovel and/or blow snow onto the curb, not into the street.
- Shovel snow to the right side of your driveway (facing the street) to minimize the amount of snow entering your driveway.
- To ensure the safety of pedestrians, residents must remove snow from sidewalks following a snow fall. Please remember that children are walking to schools and bus stops all over town.
In the event of deep snow, please shovel around your mailbox and fire hydrants near your house for your safety and your neighbors' safety.


