RECYCLING COLLECTION



WHAT GOES IN THE BLUE RECYCLE CONTAINER

- ◆ Aluminium & Steel Cans
- ◆ Flattened Cardboard
- ◆ Jars, Plastic & Glass Bottles
- ◆ Newspapers



WHAT DOESN'T GO IN THE BLUE RECYCLE CONTAINER

- ◆ Plastic Bags
- ◆ Trash, Yard Waste, or Food
- ◆ Hoses, Ropes, Chains or Cords
- ◆ Buckets
- ◆ Styrofoam
- ◆ Pots or Ceramics

YARD WASTE COLLECTION



WHAT GOES IN THE GREEN FENCING

ORGANIC waste generated during regular household gardening. If it's not an immediate, organic by-product of the earth, it's trash.

Grass, Leaves, Plants, Weeds, Sticks/Branches*, Bushes & Brushes*

*4 ft/50 lb weight limit per item. Bundled and tied with string or twine only

WHAT DOESN'T GO IN THE GREEN FENCING

Plastic Bags, Trash, Fencing, Animal Waste, Dirt, Rocks, Brick Garden Hoses, Bottles, Flower Pots, Carpet/Rugs, Food Waste Mulch, Fertilizier.



TRASH COLLECTION



WHAT GOES IN THE GREEN TRASH CONTAINER

Most household trash can be placed INSIDE the green trash containers. No trash is to be placed around the outside of the container.

- ◆ Yard Waste
- ◆ Furniture
- ◆ Dead Animals
